


Fire Chief Report January 14, 2018

1. The District ran a total of 34 calls for the month of December 2018

- 2. Projects currently working on;
 - a. SOG's & SOP's This is an ongoing project.
 - b. ISO rating Continue to work on this project
 - c. District Policy, Procedure and SOG Manual Work in progress
- 3. We have received the last Conflagration check. See Financial Report.
- 4. Flying M Sub-Station is 95% complete. Doing some fine tuning and should have the Engine in around the end of the month.
- 5. The New Command Vehicle is in service and the Tank and pump have been used twice now.
- 6. I did submit a Grant to SDAO for a 50/50 match for video surveillance system for the Fire Station. Total cost is \$4385.00. We were notified last week that the District has been awarded and we have until June 2019 to have completed the project. Working on.
- 7. We will be ordering new Helmets by the end of the month for everyone, as the current ones have reached the end of their lifespan. The cost is about \$12,000.

- 8. There are several other grants coming up, (Homeland Security, USDA, and the SAFER Act). We will be looking at these and see want fits into the supporting the district. Working with Yamhill PD and Dundee Fire on the Homeland Security Grant for new Mobile Tri-Band radios. Murray Paolo is helping write this grant. There is a 10% match if awarded. Cost about \$7,500.
- 9. There is also another grant opened that we are looking for a Type III Brush Rig. It is due in Feb. 2019
- 10. On October 17, 2018 I met with ISO regarding the District's ISO rating. It was a positive meeting and a good chance that we can improve the District's overall rating. Working on the paperwork and items that we need to perform and document. Hoping to have this complete by the end of the year. Still working on this, have gathered a lot of the information from the other districts.
- 11. We did submit the AFG for new Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus. That grant is around \$200,000 with the district having to pay 5% or \$10,000 if we are awarded. We will not find out until sometime next year (around summer time). The cost to the district to have the grant written was \$750.00. Waiting
- 12. A couple of weeks ago we learned that we had a leak in the propane line from the tank to the building. Friday, we relocated the propane tank and ran a new line. Tank had to be relocated because it had to be 10' from the Generator and we could not cover the Generator with the Propane Tank there. This has been completed.
- 13. On January 5, 2019 Cliff Jensen passed away. Services will be January 18, 2019 at 10:00 at the Yamhill LDS Church. There will be a procession from Macy's to Yamhill that morning. Cliff served as a Volunteer with McMinnville Fire for 10 years and was Firefighter of the Year in 1973. He also served as a Yamhill Fire Board member from 1979 to 1983. Currently his son is a Lieutenant with the Yamhill Fire Protection District. Flowers have been ordered from the Fire Board.
